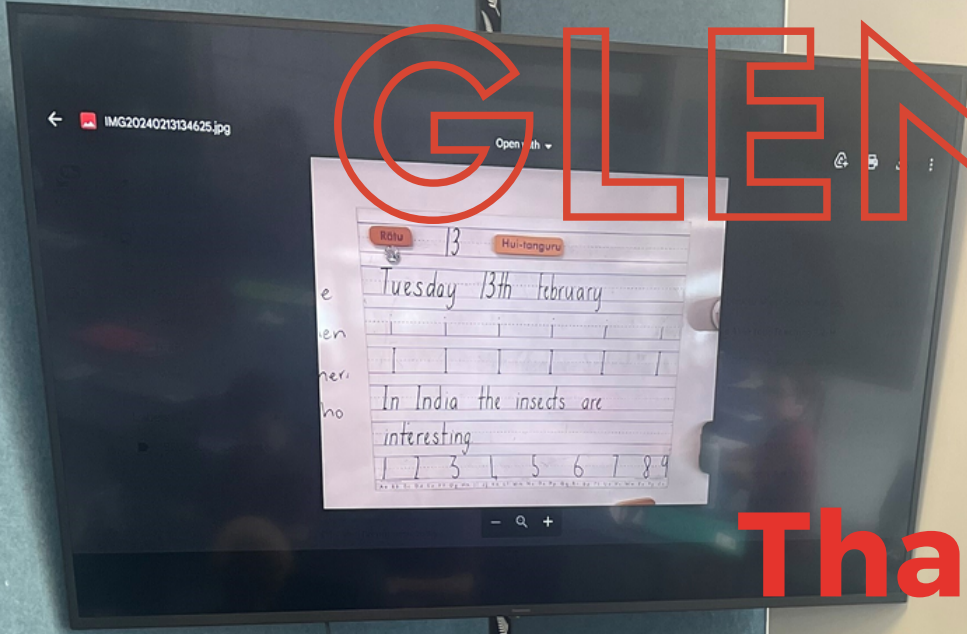
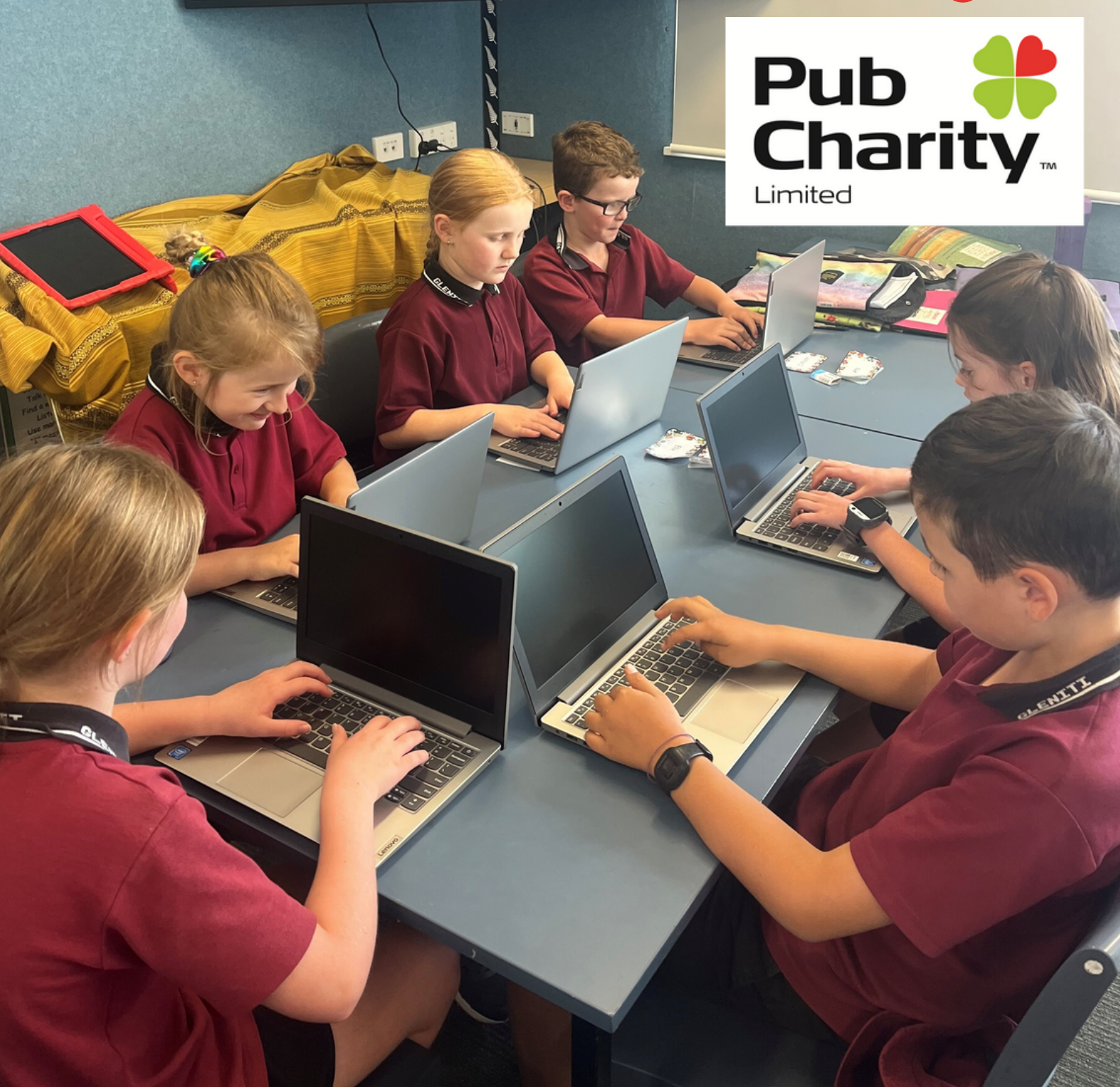

Room 8 students are this week's cover stars as they showcase new equipment purchased through a generous donation from Pub Charity. In December 2023, Pub Charity awarded Gleniti School a \$25,000 grant which enabled us to purchase 14 new 65 inch televisions, 34 laptops and 7 ipads. This funding helps us to replace our aging equipment and will allow us to maintain a ratio of 1 device for every 2 students across our school. Our students are lucky to have this equipment to support our integration of Digital Technology and to learn skills such as coding, creating slideshows, animation and publishing.

SKOOL LOOP APP

Downloading the Skool Loop app - a step by step guide

Once you have downloaded the Skool Loop App, via either your Google Play or App store, please follow the below instructions to select your school -

- Open the Skool Loop App - you will land on a welcome page.
- Click the 'Select your schools' this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school or follow the country/region prompts.
- Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side.
- Tap the 'select schools' button in the top right corner.
- Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page.
- Subscribe to the groups that are relevant to you, then click the 'go back' button on your phone, which will bring you to the main screen of your schools app.



COMMUNITY NOTICES

Oceans Grief and Loss is a peer support programme for people who have experienced loss in their life. The losses covered usually come from the death of a significant person or experience of separation/divorce. The focus of this programme is providing a safe environment for participants to talk about their loss/es and the change/s that have occurred then look ahead to a preferred future living and coping with the loss/change. Each eight-week programme explores understanding emotions, anger, the story and resiliency that has helped support through time of change. We have seen many people go through the programme and have numerous success stories of how it has helped (Almost 500 since Oceans started in 2006). We also have a programme for adults that runs over six weeks and can be beneficial for the adults in the family.

As a non-Government funded charitable trust board, we are responsible for ensuring the financial and educational excellence and long-term viability of Life Education Trust Mid and South Canterbury.

We are extremely proud of what a small team of Trustees can accomplish, along with our administrator and two fully qualified teacher-trained Educators. Together we cater for approximately 8000 children per year and take the lessons to over 65 schools around the wider region.

In the previous 18 months we have successfully rebranded the Harold Club to become Friends of Harold (encompassing every type of support we receive), rewrapped the entire mobile classroom, purchased a replacement truck, installed a wheelchair lift (to enable children with disabilities to enter safely) and covered the ever-increasing costs across all functions of the trust. This is achieved by 10 volunteer trustees who represent our region of Glenavy to Rakaia and as far afield as Mt Cook.

Life Education Trust Mid-South Canterbury could not achieve this without the help of our local communities.
